2.5%K, 1.3%S, 0.25%Ca plus 12% humic acid as potassium humates w/v%

**Baileys Humic12** is a liquid fertiliser consisting of **12%** humic acid which improves nutrient uptake, retains nutrients and water, improves soil structure and provides the necessary carbon for microorganisms to develop. Humus is a practical way of controlling nitrogen loss and adding carbon to the soil profile.

Humates are a form of active carbon and the major component of soil organic matter. Humates provide the charged surface for nutrients to latch onto.

- Improves availability of trace elements especially iron, manganese and zinc which can be a major issue in high pH calcareous soils.
- Increases cation exchange capacity.

- Increases water infiltration.
- Improves soil structure on sandy soils.
- Humic acid helps with protein synthesis, photosynthesis and plant enzyme activity.
- Can be used for both foliar and fertigation.

Nutrient can stain walkways and will need to be washed off prior to irrigation. Keep away from water sources such as ponds, pools, etc

APPLICATION RATES - FOLIAR Minimum dilution rate 1:100 Rate for turf 1:10

Crop	(Lt/Ha)	Comments
Turf	5 - 10lt per ha	Apply up to 4 times within the growing season.
Horticulture	5 - 10lt per ha	Apply up to 4 times per crop season.
Vineyards	5lt per ha	Apply up to 6 times within the season after budburst.
Fruit crops including stonefruit, citrus	5lt per ha	Apply up to 4 times within the season.

Fertigation rates vary on application. A general guide is 10lt - 20lt per ha.
