Contains a quality Wetting Agent: Grosorb® has been added to the mix to ensure good moisture penetration, even drainage and re-wettability.

Has optimal air-filled porosity and soil particle size: Composted pine bark and quality coarse sand is incorporated into the mix to provide optimal structure and air space for plant establishment
