APPLICATION

New Plantings:

After selecting the position for your new rose or citrus plant, dig a hole large enough to accommodate the root system. Replace the backfill and apply 250 grams of Rose & Citrus fertiliser per tree/bush. Work into the loose topsoil and water well. Newly planted citrus trees require regular feeding until established. During the first 6 months or until visibly growing vigorously, apply Rose & Citrus Fertiliser monthly at a rate of 250 grams per tree.

Established Plants/Trees:

For Citrus Trees the amount of fertiliser required to promote vigorous growth and ensure an abundant crop is based on a rate of 500 grams of Rose & Citrus Fertiliser for every year of the tree's age. Thus a 4 year old tree would require 2kg of fertiliser that year. This is best applied in 4 equal applications, in September, December, March & May.



APPLICATION CALENDAR — Citrus

(best applied during months coloured dark green)

JAN	FEB	MAR	APR	MAY	JUN	JUL	AUG	SEP	OCT	NOV	DEC

For Rose bushes and subsequent feeding of new plants, use approximately 50 to 100 grams of Rose & Citrus Fertiliser per bush. It should be applied during the months of August, November, February and May.

APPLICATION CALENDAR — Rose

(best applied during months coloured dark green)

JAN	FEB	MAR	APR	MAY	JUN	JUL	AUG	SEP	OCT	NOV	DEC

The fertiliser should always be applied within the drip line area beneath the tree/bush foliage. Simply broadcast the fertiliser around this area, working into the soil thoroughly with a garden hoe/fork and water well.

SIZES AVAILABLE: 20kg bags, bulka bags & bulk

CAUTION

Nutrient can stain walkways and will need to be washed off prior to irrigation. Keep away from water sources such as ponds, pools etc.
